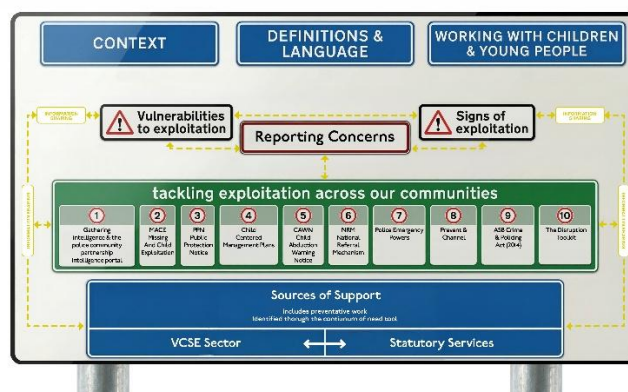


Launching Today! A new Roadmap for Practitioners to help us CE The Signs of Child Exploitation



Dear colleague

Published today on the OSCP website, this online guide has been developed as a 'roadmap' to support our ongoing #CEtheSigns of child exploitation campaign. The resources have been designed to support us all to work together to protect children from harm and stop this abuse from happening in the first place.

The roadmap has been produced for professionals who have concerns about child exploitation and the aim is to provide information on thresholds and pathways and to signpost to local support for children and their families.

The work has been undertaken by a multiagency, cross partnership working group and is underpinned by the [Cornwall and Isles of Scilly Exploitation Strategy 2025 - 2028](#).

Representatives from partner agencies across Cornwall and The Isles of Scilly contributed to this piece of work - from children's social care, health services, Devon & Cornwall Police, Safer Cornwall and the voluntary and community sector.
